Since 1972, Save-A-Pet has cared for tens of thousands of animals. WOW! If Save-A-Pet wasn’t around all these years—what would have happened to these animals? Many would have been abandoned. Some would not have survived at all.

2010 has been “bittersweet” for Save-A-Pet. They’ve helped pursue justice for Justice—a dog shot and killed just yards from our adoption center—after being dumped by his owners. They’ve had another dog, Stevie, abandoned in the freezing cold with extreme trauma to her eyes. Save-A-Pet also learned how one of their senior pit bulls, Sadie, saved the life of her recent adopter. Save-A-Pet even had an older cat, Dumbledore; find a forever home with one of their wonderful volunteers despite his medical issues and being relinquished after fifteen years.

Save-A-Pet’s First Annual “Summer of Love” campaign is 100% web-based—keeping costs and environmental impact to a minimum, and helping to ensure we all have ample time to enjoy the summer!

I once heard that \$1 feeds a dog or a cat for a day. However, I had no idea of the true extent of the expenses that Save-A-Pet’s incurs. Did you know that it costs Save-A-Pet \$1,000 per year just to care for a healthy animal? Can you believe some of the costs they face every year:

- Average costs for feline SubQ fluids, FELK and FIV testing: **\$6,200**
- Average costs for feline prescription food: **\$9,100**
- Average costs for canine prescription food: **\$9,400**
- Average costs for dental cleanings and extractions (dogs and cats): **\$38,000**

Save-A-Pet also intends to “remodel” and relaunch therapy and interaction rooms—one for dogs and one for cats—in the coming year. In these rooms, animals with unique medical or emotional needs can spend dedicated time working with staff, volunteers, and health & wellness experts on their healing needs.

Did you know that Save-A-Pet is funded solely by the generosity of donations? I will be raising and collecting funds using **FirstGiving.com**, a safe and easy way to donate. You can pledge any amount of money anytime from June 22nd through September 18th. You can create your own fundraising page, too.

My goal is to raise a minimum of \$300 in that time.
